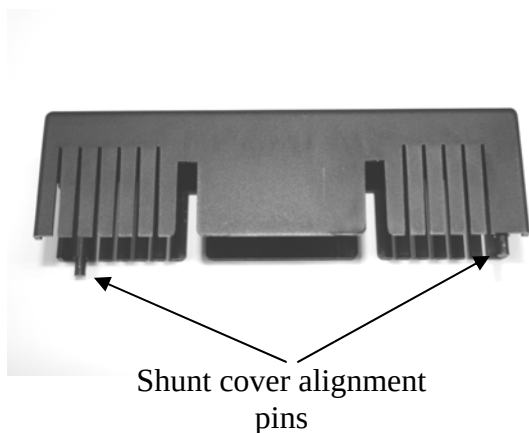
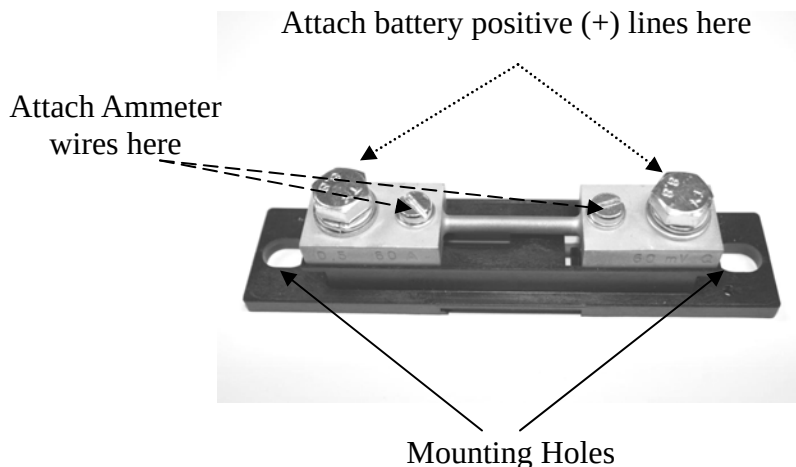

Caution! This shunt will only work with VDO Viewline ammeters. Do not connect to any other ammeter or damage may result!

Installation Instructions:

1. **Disconnect battery before proceeding!**
2. Select mounting position for shunt. Secure shunt to mounting location using 8mm bolts (not included)
3. Attach positive (+) cables that carry vehicles amperage load to outer ends of shunt, using bolt, lock washer and flat washer supplied
4. Connect the Viewline ammeter green and blue/black wires to the small screws on the shunt (1 wire per screw.) It does not matter which wire is connected to which screw.
5. Attach shunt cover to shunt, aligning pins on cover to the small holes on the base of the shunt.
